

Dear Future Sponsor,

We are the Blue Crew Robotics Team comprised of just 20 students from Mt. Blue Regional School District and the Foster Technical Education Center out of Farmington, Maine. The team is part of the FIRST Robotics Competition program. We are mostly self-funded with some support from Foster Technical Center. The team relies on our own fundraising efforts as well as sponsorships and donations.

FIRST Robotics is a program that allows students to explore their strengths and expand their access to education surrounding science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM). On the first Sunday in January, a challenge is released; students then have six weeks to design, build, and test a robot before competitions start. Teams compete in two district events throughout New England with the goal of qualifying for the New England District Championship. Students are able to develop business skills and interact with the community around them because of the fundraising done. As a result of our fundraising efforts from our Root Beer Float Stand, the team received the Entrepreneurship Award at the 2018 Pine Tree FRC Competition.

It is of the utmost importance to keep out-of-pocket costs for individual members of the team as low as possible. It is our belief that the financial status of a student should not disqualify him or her from participating in such an enriching opportunity. Achieving our goal is no small feat, as the budget for the next competition season totals around \$30,000, and is broken down below:

Robot Parts .....	\$8,000
Registration Expenses .....	\$9,000
Travel Expenses .....	\$13,000
